2013 Overview

This past year was a milestone year for the Mustard Seed Foundation, marking the 30th anniversary of our incorporation in 1983. In these 30 years, the world has changed and we have experienced many joys and challenges, both as families and as a Foundation. Through these years, we can say with confidence that God has remained the same – our loving Savior, Provider, Guide, and Redeemer.

The year 2013 also was a time of change. After nearly a decade with multiple offices located worldwide, the Foundation entered the year with only a single US office. Identifying and developing strong grassroots grants internationally has become more challenging without the benefit of international staff. Our five US staff members have been remarkably flexible, resourceful, and joyful in the midst of a major foundation restructuring. We want to thank Brian Bakke, Scott Bakke, Eric Hornberger, Lonni Jackson, and Jill Jensen, whose commitment to the mission of MSF has not wavered. We are profoundly grateful for the important work they do each day on behalf of the Foundation.

Mustard Seed continues to partner financially with churches, individuals, and nonprofit organizations worldwide to introduce people to Jesus Christ and to “make disciples” in all the nations of the world. In 2013 the Foundation had an operating budget of about \$2.3 million. We awarded 238 grants totaling approximately \$1.1 million. Our average grant size of \$4,562 in 2013 is at the low end of our average grant size for most of the Foundation’s history.

We celebrated the 20th year of the Harvey Fellows program, our scholarship program that supports talented Christians who are attending top graduate programs and who God has called to be leaders and non-traditional missionaries in business, media, the arts, government, and academia. In 2013 we awarded funding to eight new Fellows. Altogether, MSF supported 39 graduate students with fellowships totaling \$344,000.

Six years ago we initiated Theology of Work grants, awarded to seminaries and other organizations to develop and teach marketplace theology. In 2013 we awarded \$200,000 in support of 35 Theology of Work courses, predominately outside of the United States. These courses continue to empower pastors and lay leaders to more effectively integrate their faith with their vocations and the culture at large.

Last summer, eight members of our Junior Board joined Brian Bakke, Jill Nauta, and Daniel Thompson for a weeklong Los Angeles urban plunge. The group visited a wide variety of churches and MSF grantees, interviewed several Harvey Fellows, and awarded grants after site visits. The Junior Board reported lots of pranks and fun, and also faith-building experiences and discussions. We want to thank Jr. Board Chair Emma Bakke for her continuing service and welcome Andrew Harvey as he joins her as Co-chair for this coming year.

We want to thank our daughter Margaret Bakke Canales, who rotated off the Senior Board, for her five years of service. Margaret spent more time than any board member (except Ray Bakke) with MSF staff in the field in Africa and India, giving her a tangible sense of the needs and aspirations of our grantees. We welcome Daniel Thompson to a five-year term of service on the board. He has experience in, and a heart for, Somalia, Ethiopia, and South Africa.

The apostle James admonished his brothers and sisters in Christ to “count it all joy” when they encountered trials, because as they learned to trust Christ in the midst of adversity, their faith would deepen and grow. When we count our joys over the 30 years of MSF, two things spring to mind. First, we experience joy every time we partner with Christians around the globe who desire to love God and to love their neighbors with the love of Jesus Christ. Second, we find tremendous joy in growing more deeply in our faith and in our relationships with family members on this journey of stewardship and faithfulness through the Foundation.

We pray that you will be encouraged by reading this report.

Grants Overview

In 2013 we awarded \$1,085,692 in grants matched by local churches to help establish 235 new innovative, grass-roots ministries in the largest urban centers of the world.

As our name implies, the Mustard Seed Foundation provides seed funding for small startup projects of churches and Christian organizations around the world. We seek to partner with local congregations that identify, equip, and support their members who are called to specific areas of ministry in the Church and society. We look for initiatives that offer innovative approaches to church-based ministries.

Mustard Seed seeks to help launch projects through its grants as a minority partner, providing funds over a limited time period, and in a way that encourages self-sufficiency and reliance on indigenous church support. We consider local church accountability and financial support to be primary indicators of the priority and integrity of a particular project and key to its long-term sustainability. All of the funds given as grants are matched by funds from local churches connected to the projects.

The Foundation recognizes the unique challenges and opportunities faced by urban churches. As the world rapidly urbanizes, we believe that investing in churches located in large cities to be particularly strategic. The Foundation awards most grants in the largest urban centers of the world.

Mustard Seed awards grants to a wide variety of projects. We typically fund initiatives that share the gospel with non-Christians (outreach), generate income and economic decision-making opportunities to poorer Christians (empowerment), or equip Christians to better proclaim and demonstrate the gospel (discipleship).

T.A. Bakke Award

Each year the Mustard Seed Foundation designates one grant award as a special tribute to the life of one of our founding board members. Tollef A. Bakke was a second generation Norwegian immigrant who lived and worked in the Pacific Northwest and Colorado. He also participated in a trip to the Holy Land that profoundly influenced his faith.

We recognize the grant award to Mosaic @ the space as our 2013 Tollef A. Bakke Award. This was a \$3,000 grant matching church support to expand an annual block party celebration in honor of National Aboriginal Day in downtown Vancouver, BC, Canada.

Savina Tong Award

Savina Tong represented the Foundation for eight years to encourage the work of local churches in East Asia. Savina helped the Foundation to connect with the fast-growing church of mainland China as well as in the more open locations of Hong Kong and Taiwan. Since her passing in 2010, the Foundation has selected a grant award each year as a tribute to her life and ministry among us.

We recognize the grant award to Trinity Harvest Church in Taiwan as our 2013 Savina Tong Award. This was a \$15,000 grant matching church support to establish a new church in the Taiwanese city of Kaohsiung.

Harvey Fellows Program

In 2013 the Foundation invested \$344,000 in support of 39 graduate students preparing to enter strategic ministry in academia, the arts, and the marketplace. We were privileged to award 8 new fellowships to an extraordinary group of graduate students from around the world.

The Mustard Seed Foundation initiated the Harvey Fellows Program in 1992 to mark, equip, and encourage followers of Jesus Christ who seek to actively integrate their faith and vocations as leaders in strategic occupations where Christians appear to be underrepresented. This idea grew from our understanding of God as Creator and Redeemer, not only

of human beings, but also of society's disciplines and structures. Our desire is to identify, prepare, and celebrate this generation's Josephs, Lydias, Daniels, and Esthers—Christians who will assume positions of leadership and influence in society. The Harvey Fellowship is a stipend of \$12,000 that may be renewed for up to two additional years. The award is given to outstanding students enrolled at a premier graduate degree program and is therefore very competitive. Harvey Fellows typically attend schools considered by professionals to be among the top five globally in a given subject area or specialty.

Theology of Work

In 2013 we awarded 35 Theology of Work (TOW) grants totaling \$200,044 to seminaries and ministries worldwide. Over 5,000 students participated in courses in hopes that through them churches will actively teach their congregants a strong theology of work that brings the same sense of calling to one's work in the world as one's work within the Church.

The Theology of Work grant program was established in 2007 by the Mustard Seed Foundation in collaboration with Bakke Graduate University (BGU). The aim of this special grant initiative is to enable theological institutions and training organizations worldwide to instruct seminarians, pastors, and educators in a biblical basis of a theology of work. It is our desire to see those trained through our grants begin teaching and modeling this theological concept in their own churches and ministries. This theological understanding empowers lay people to infuse their Christian faith in the institutions, structures, and industries in which they work throughout the week.

TOW grants are awarded to theological institutions; both formal and non-formal, to create and offer courses that teach students a theology of work. The institutions are encouraged to integrate this theology into their core curriculum to continue to teach the course after the grant-funded classes are completed. The TOW grant program is administered by BGU, which fosters a network of people and resources specializing in developing and teaching curriculum for theology of work.

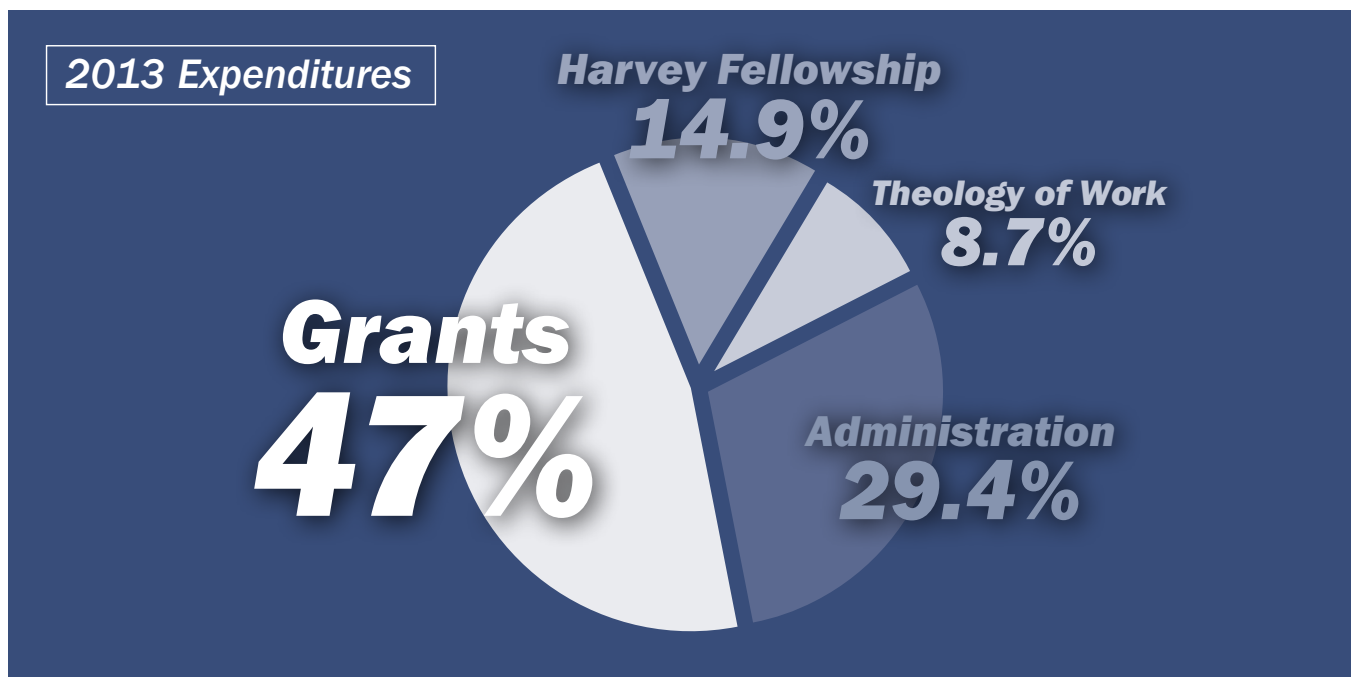

Financials

The Foundation's expenditures totaled \$2.3 million in 2013. Over 70 percent of these funds were given through 273 grants to churches and Christian organizations, and 40 scholarships to individuals. The remaining 29 percent was used to administer this work.

Providing grants for small startup projects of churches in major urban centers worldwide remains the primary giving area

of the Foundation, as it has been since the Foundation's inception. The remainder of the Foundation's giving was channeled through the Harvey Fellowship and the Theology of Work grant program.
