The Foundation was created as an expression of the Bakke's desire to be faithful stewards of the financial resources entrusted to them, to bring together the members of their extended families into common ministry, and to advance the Kingdom of God. The Foundation provides grants primarily to churches worldwide that are undertaking new ministry projects including outreach, discipleship, and economic empowerment. The Foundation also awards scholarships to Christians pursuing advanced educational degrees in preparation for leadership roles in society. The Foundation affirms the Lausanne Covenant as its missional commitment to the world. All directors and staff of the Mustard Seed Foundation are committed followers of Jesus Christ.

2018 Overview

Dear Friends,

Once again, we take time to reflect on the work of the Mustard Seed Foundation during the past year and to report to our grantees and other stakeholders. Each year we try to give a public accounting for our stewardship of the Foundation's resources, in order to remain transparent and accountable as a Christ-centered organization. We continue to be thankful for God's abundant mercy and faithfulness to the Mustard Seed Foundation year after year.

The Foundation's annual budget and giving priorities have been fairly consistent over the past few years. In 2018, our total annual operations were just over \$2.6 million, with nearly \$2 million granted in our three giving areas: church-based granting, the Harvey Fellows Program, and the Theology of Work grants program. We awarded 218 grants to churches and other ministries in 59 countries worldwide, with our average grant size remaining \$6,100. Our seasoned staff members continue to travel to visit prior and prospective grantees, often conducting workshops for leaders from small churches to help them learn how to write a grant proposal. We are encouraged by increased levels of granting in the Middle East, India and Western Europe. We also continue to identify strong ministries in Central and South America.

In 2018 we supported 38 Christian graduate students through the Harvey Fellows Program, providing \$356,000 in fellowship stipends. We selected nine new Fellows in February, who will receive a \$16,000 stipend each year for one, two or three years depending on the amount of time remaining in their program of study. In June we hosted our biannual Summer Institute, ably led by Jerry and Jeannie Herbert and alumni Fellows Olivia Mather and Caleb Spencer. The Summer Institute is a key component of the HF experience, allowing Fellows to form lasting relationships with others and to explore more fully the integration of faith into their studies, vocations, and lives.

The 2018 Theology of Work grants, totaling \$202,000 were made to support 25 Theology of Work courses worldwide. Lowell Bakke, who administers the grant program, and a

growing team of TOW teachers have increased their efforts to offer curricula and materials via the TOW website, to identify colleges and seminaries that want to teach TOW as a core part of their curriculum, and to identify and train new TOW teachers to facilitate the program even more broadly in the future. It is gratifying to witness how transformative an understanding of God's view of our work can be in a variety of cultures.

Over the 35 years of Mustard Seed's existence, we have relied largely on the talent, wisdom and dedication of three generations of family members to guide MSF. We want to highlight two family members with gratitude in this letter. Brantley Harvey, Eileen's father, went home to heaven in December at the age of 88. Brantley helped incorporate MSF in 1983 and served on the Board since its inception. He contributed constant good will, fiscal realism, and abounding faith throughout his tenure on the Board. We all miss his gentlemanly voice, his warm smile, and his twinkling blue eyes. Scott Bakke, who came to work at the Foundation in early 1999, left employment at MSF at the end of 2018. Scott, who kept our technology and data base operational, was also in many ways the Foundation's historian. Thank you, Scott, for 20 years of service.

We also want to thank Daniel Thompson for five years of service as he rotates off the Board. Daniel participated vigorously in reading Harvey Fellows applications and in the selection process. We welcome Laura Harvey onto the Board to fill this five-year position.

The longer we walk with Jesus Christ, in many respects the simpler it becomes. We are commanded to love the Lord with all our heart, mind, soul, and strength, and to love our neighbors as ourselves. This command encompasses a whole world of faith, prayer, priorities, and action. Please pray for us as we attempt, by God's grace, to live this out in our work and relationships. We also pray this will be true for you.

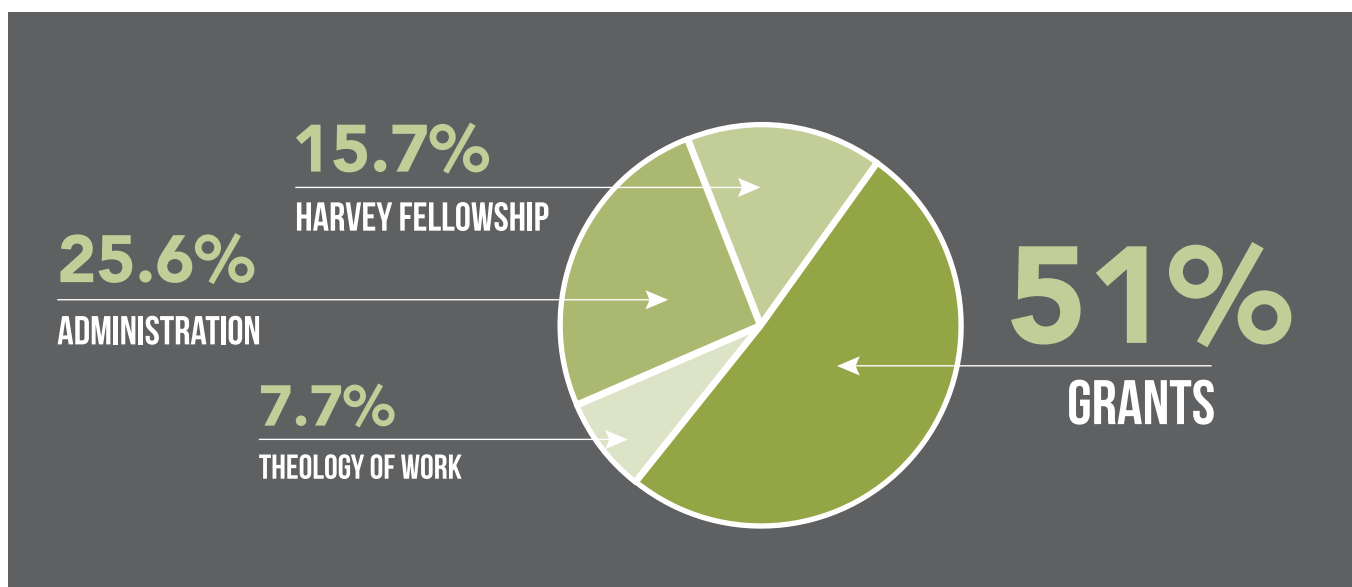
Financials

The Foundation's expenditures totaled over \$2.6 million in 2018. 74 percent of these funds were given through 218 grants to churches and 38 scholarships to individuals.

Providing grants for small startup projects of churches in major urban centers worldwide remains the primary giving

area of the Foundation, as it has been since the Foundation's inception. The remainder of the Foundation's giving was channeled through the Harvey Fellowship, the Theology of Work grant program and matching gifts.

2018 Balance Sheet

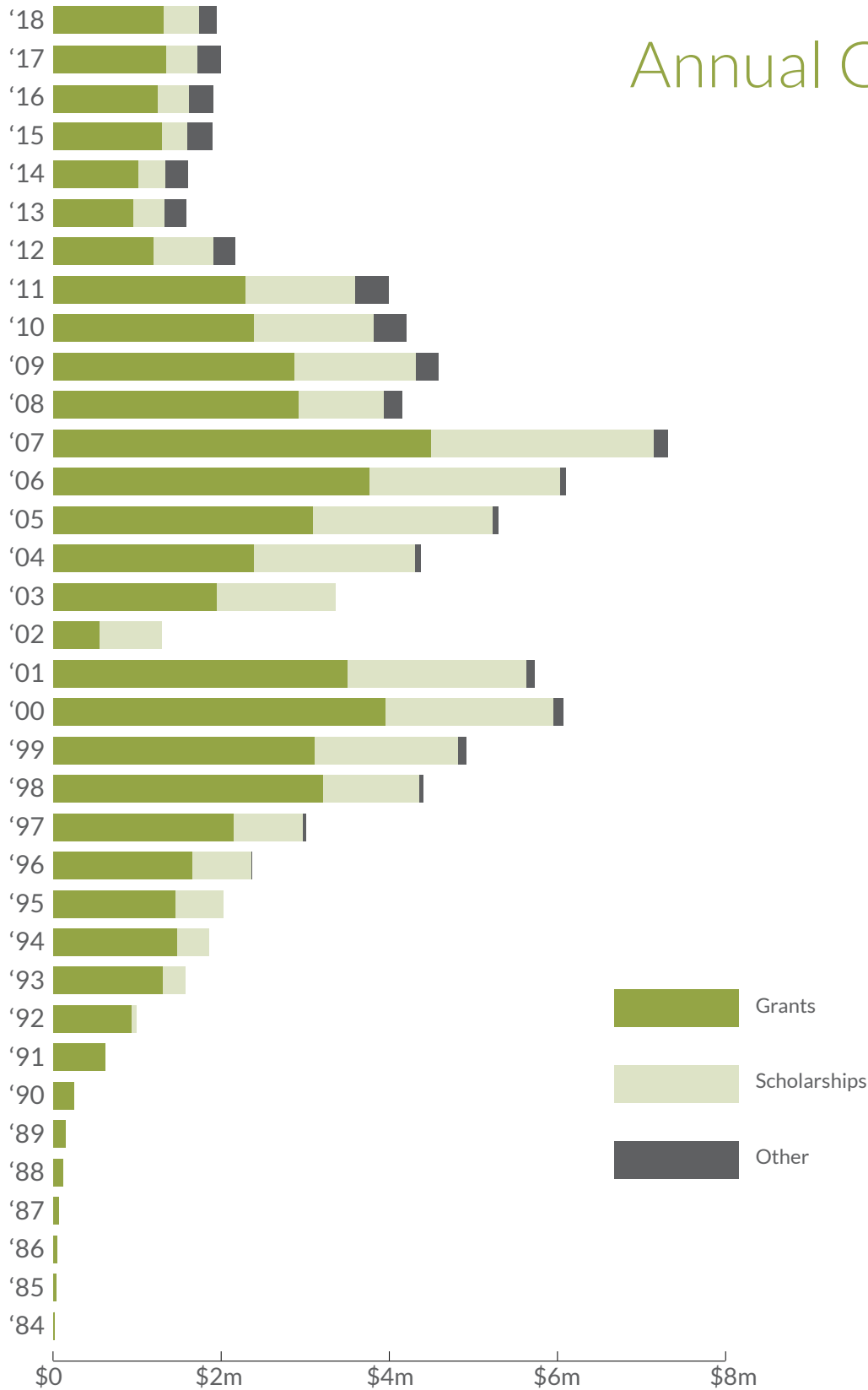

Grants Overview

In 2018 we awarded \$1,331,947 in grants matched by local churches to help establish 218 new innovative, grass-roots ministries mostly in the largest urban centers of the world.

As our name implies, the Mustard Seed Foundation provides seed funding for small startup projects primarily to churches around the world. We seek to partner with local congregations that identify, equip, and support their members who are called to specific areas of ministry in the Church and society. We look for initiatives that offer innovative approaches to church-based ministries.

Mustard Seed seeks to help launch projects through its grants as a minority partner, providing funds over a limited time period, and in a way that encourages self-sufficiency and reliance on indigenous church support. We consider local church accountability and financial support to be primary indicators of the priority and integrity of a particular project and key to its long-term sustainability. All of the funds given as grants are matched by funds from local churches connected to the projects.

The Foundation recognizes the unique challenges and opportunities faced by urban churches. As the world rapidly urbanizes, we believe that investing in churches located in large cities to be particularly strategic. The Foundation awards most grants in the largest urban centers of the world.

Mustard Seed awards grants to a wide variety of projects. We typically fund initiatives that share the gospel with non-Christians (outreach), generate income and economic decision-making opportunities to poorer Christians (empowerment), or equip Christians to better proclaim and demonstrate the gospel (discipleship).

T.A. Bakke Award

Each year the Mustard Seed Foundation designates one grant award as a special tribute to the life of one of our founding board members. Tollef A. Bakke was a second generation Norwegian immigrant who lived and worked in the Pacific Northwest and Colorado. He also participated in a trip to the Holy Land that profoundly influenced his faith.

We recognize the grant award to Al Marg Al Sharkia Evangelical Church in Cairo, Egypt as our 2018 T.A. Bakke Award. This was a \$3,600 grant to establish a preschool outreach ministry in the Al Marg community.

Savina Tong Award

Savina Tong represented the Foundation for eight years to encourage the work of local churches in East Asia. Savina helped the Foundation to connect with the fast-growing church of mainland China as well as in the more open locations of Hong Kong and Taiwan. Since her passing in 2010, the Foundation has selected a grant award each year as a tribute to her life and ministry among us.

We recognize the grant award to The Gospel Center in Osaka, Japan as our 2018 Savina Tong Award. This was a \$15,000 grant to establish a church in the Yamada community of Suita City of Osaka.

Harvey Fellows Program

In 2018 the Foundation invested \$410,047 in support of 38 graduate students preparing to enter strategic vocations in academia, the arts, and the marketplace. We were privileged to award 9 new fellowships to an extraordinary group of graduate students from around the world. The Foundation hosted a Summer Institute in June of 2018 in Arlington, VA to bring Fellows together for a dialogue on the integration of faith and vocation.

The Mustard Seed Foundation initiated the Harvey Fellows Program in 1992 to mark, equip, and encourage followers of Jesus Christ who seek to actively integrate their faith and vocations as leaders in strategic occupations where Christians appear to be underrepresented. This idea grew

from our understanding of God as Creator and Redeemer, not only of human beings, but also of society's disciplines and structures. Our desire is to identify, prepare, and celebrate this generation's Josephs, Lydias, Daniels, and Esthers—Christians who will assume positions of leadership and influence in society. The Harvey Fellowship is a stipend of \$16,000 that may be renewed for up to two additional years. The award is given to outstanding students enrolled at a premier graduate degree program and is therefore very competitive. Harvey Fellows typically attend schools considered by professionals to be among the top five globally in a given subject area or specialty.

Theology of Work

In 2018 we awarded 25 Theology of Work (TOW) grants totaling \$201,640 to seminaries and ministries worldwide. 5,964 students participated in courses in hopes that through them churches will actively teach their congregants a strong theology of work that brings the same sense of calling to one's work in the world as one's work within the Church.

The Theology of Work grant program was established in 2007 in collaboration with Bakke Graduate University (BGU). The aim of this special grant initiative is to enable theological institutions and training organizations worldwide to instruct seminarians, pastors, and educators in a biblical basis of a theology of work. It is our desire to see those trained through our grants begin teaching and modeling this theological

concept in their own churches and ministries. This theological understanding empowers lay people to infuse their Christian faith in the institutions, structures, and industries in which they work throughout the week.

TOW grants are awarded to theological institutions; both formal and non-formal, to create and offer courses that teach students a theology of work. The institutions are encouraged to integrate this theology into their core curriculum to continue to teach the course after the grant-funded classes are completed. The TOW grant program is administered by BGU, which fosters a network of people and resources specializing in developing and teaching curriculum for theology of work.
